

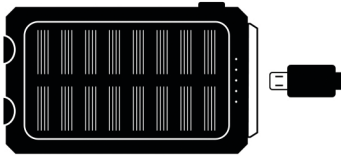


SOLAR CHARGER

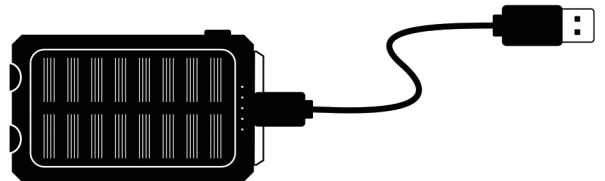
TO CHARGE:

BY PLUGGING CHARGER IN

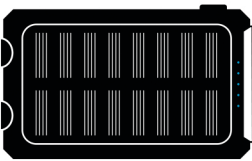
- › Flip down the protective plastic cover on the top of the solar charger and plug in the provided micro USB charging cord into the center port.



- › Once connected, insert the USB end into any USB accepting charger and plug into the wall.

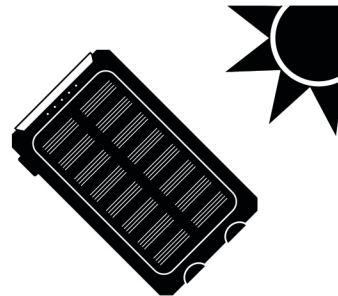


- › The blue lights will indicate the charge level. At full charge, all 5 lights will be blue and NOT blinking.



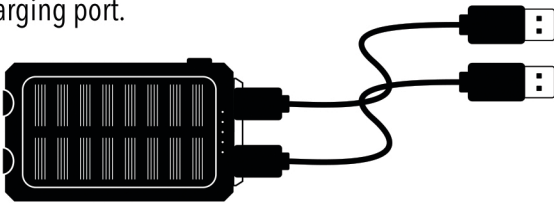
BY SOLAR POWER

- › Leave the charger solar-face up in direct sunlight. The sunlight will charge the battery at a slower rate than charging by plugging the unit in.

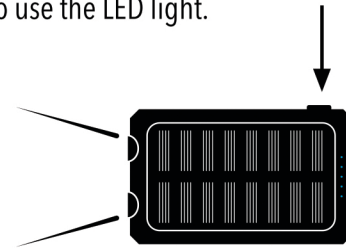


TO USE:

- › When charged, plug in up to two electronic devices via the 2 USB ports located on either side of the micro-USB charging port.



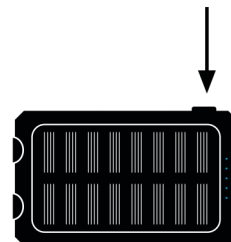
- › Hold down the power button on the top left side of the charger to use the LED light.



- › Once the electronic device is plugged into the solar charger, charging will begin immediately.



- › Holding the power button down will turn the light off.



- › A single push of the power button will illuminate the lights and indicate how much battery life is left.
